We have had a very busy first week back of the final term in Mallard Class. In Maths, Mallards have been learning how to measure length in centimetres using a ruler. First, we learnt how to compare size by saying whether an object was taller, shorter, longer, and wider than another

object. We then learnt how to use a ruler, and know that when measuring things you must start at the zero. We practised our measuring skills, and then applied them to a real life context. We made curtains and carpets for Mrs Fellows dolls house as it was looking a bit worse for wear! On Thursday, the

Year 1's explained how to measure objects to the Reception children so that they could make things for the doll's house too. In English, we wrote a recount of our Easter holidays, described dinosaurs and learnt how to add the suffix - ed to words to turn them into the past tense. We created

dinosaur silhouette artwork too.
